- C. Other Issues & Alternative Funding Proposals:
  1. Trailer Bill Language for Federal Roger's Amendment—**Approved. (Vote 3-0)**
  2. Two Issues regarding Medi-Cal Managed Care Tax—**Modified (Vote 3-0)**. Specifically, **(1)** adopted a January 1, 2014 sunset date; and **(2)** reduced Medi-Cal by \$89.9 million (General Fund) to reflect the availability of \$89.9 million in revenues available in the Children's Health and Human Services Fund (continuously appropriated) from tax deposits from Medi-Cal Managed Care Plans.
  3. Use of Proposition 10 Reserves to Fund Medi-Cal Services for Children—**Held OPEN.**
  4. Health Information Technology (HITECH)—**Modified (Vote 3-0)**. Specifically, **(1)** adopted the positions and local assistance funding; and **(2)** denied TBL without prejudice since this is a new program and should be a policy bill.
