



MMBI Timeline

- **Dec. 2024** All miles must be under contract for federal ARPA dollars.
- **2025 1Q** Purchase segments come online.
- 2025 3Q 2026 4Q Joint Build segments come online.
- 2025 3Q 2026 4Q Caltrans constructed segments roll out.
- 2025 Q3 2026 4Q Leased segments of the network come online.
- 2026 Q4 All segments of the MMBI network come online.



Partnerships

Contracts

- Currently, approximately 83% of total MMBI miles are under contract.
 - Caltrans has **signed construction agreements for approximately 1,800 miles** of the network.
 - CDT has signed contracts for approximately
 6,500 miles of the MMBI network through alternative delivery methods.
 - **3,484** miles of **leases** under contract. Some leases are several thousand miles, running the length of the entire state.
 - 435 miles of network purchased.
 - **2,615** miles of **joint builds** under contract.

Network Progress / Funding

Network Development

- Of the ~\$3.5 billion in funding appropriated from the federal State-Local Fiscal Recovery Fund (SFRF) and the General Fund through the current fiscal year:
 - **\$2.9 billion** in state and federal funding has already been encumbered and is <u>under contract</u>.
 - The **remaining \$700 million** in funding will be encumbered and <u>under contract by June 2024</u>.
- Caltrans has signed Master Agreements for constructing approximately 1,800 miles of the MMBI network.
 - As of the end of March, Caltrans had started construction on more than 186 miles of the network.




Governor's Budget Proposal

Middle Mile — \$1.5 billion General Fund over two years

- **\$250 million** in 2024-25
- **\$1.25 billion** in 2025-26
- This additional funding will be necessary to construct 2,200 miles, complete the state network, and bring broadband connectivity by December 31, 2026.
