<b>AB 98</b>	<b>21</b>	<p><b>Budget Bill Jr.</b></p> <p><i>This bill makes various budget changes to SB 69, the budget conference report that was passed in March of this year. The changes are generally consistent with the Governor's May Revision proposal.</i></p>	<b>SB 71</b>
<b>AB 96</b>	<b>21</b>	<p><b>Adult Day Health Care</b></p> <p><i>This bill authorizes the administration to request a waiver for the creation of a new adult day health care-type benefit.</i></p>	<b>SB 73</b>
<b>AB 102</b>	<b>21</b>	<p><b>Health Omnibus</b></p> <p><i>Makes various statutory changes to transition community mental health programs and activities of the California Medical Assistance Commission to the Department of Health Care Services. Provides health care service in the Access to Infants and Mothers (AIM) program to be provided through fee-for-service Medi-Cal on a reimbursement basis. Makes changes to pharmacy reimbursement for Medi-Cal.</i></p>	<b>SB 75</b>
<b>AB 104</b>	<b>21</b>	<p><b>Developmental Services Omnibus</b></p> <p><i>Makes various statutory changes to developmental services programs necessary to implement provisions of the revised 2011-12 budget.</i></p>	<b>SB 76</b>
<b>AB 103</b>	<b>27</b>	<p><b>Revenues and Taxation Omnibus</b></p> <p><i>Establishes mandatory "single sales factor" and market scoring of intangibles, reforms existing tax benefits for enterprise zone programs, and modifies existing small business job creation tax credit program.</i></p>	<b>SB 79</b>
<b>AB 106</b>	<b>21</b>	<p><b>Human Services Omnibus</b></p> <p><i>Makes various statutory changes to CalWORKs and other human services programs that are necessary to implement provisions of the revised 2011-12 budget.</i></p>	<b>SB 81</b>
<b>AB 112</b>	<b>21</b>	<p><b>Current-year Budget Act Changes</b></p> <p><i>These amendments allow the Employment Development Department (EDD) to use federal funds to cover administrative costs associated with implementing the Alternative Base Period program that will allow additional unemployed persons to qualify for federal unemployment insurance benefits earlier.</i></p>	<b>SB 89</b>
<b>AB 114</b>	<b>21</b>	<p><b>Education Omnibus</b></p> <p><i>Makes various statutory changes to K-12, higher education, and child care programs that are necessary to implement provisions of the revised 2011-12 budget.</i></p>	<b>SB 85</b>

<b>AB 115</b>	<b>21</b>	<b>Transportation Omnibus</b> <i>Makes various statutory changes to transportation-related programs that are necessary implement provisions of the revised 2011-12 budget.</i>	<b>SB 91</b>
<b>AB 116</b>	<b>21</b>	<b>Public Safety Omnibus</b> <i>Makes various statutory changes to create a new community corrections department that will be responsible for oversight and leadership related to public safety realignment, reduces the current scope of the Office of the Inspector General for corrections, and makes other technical changes needed to reduce the costs of prison healthcare delivery.</i>	<b>SB 92</b>
<b>AB 119</b>	<b>21</b>	<b>General Government Omnibus</b> <i>Makes various statutory changes to various general government and state administration-related programs that are necessary implement provisions of the revised 2011-12 budget.</i>	<b>SB 97</b>
<b>AB 120</b>	<b>21</b>	<b>Resources Omnibus</b> <i>Makes various statutory changes to various natural resources and environmental protection programs that are necessary implement provisions of the revised 2011-12 budget.</i>	<b>SB 95</b>
<b>AB 122</b>	<b>21</b>	<b>Supplemental Appropriations Bill</b> <i>Appropriates \$1.2 billion to augment various items in the Budget Acts of 2009 and 2010 to cover deficiencies in specified state departmental budgets for those years.</i>	<b>SB 99</b>
<b>SCA 1x</b>	<b>27</b>	<b>Public Safety Realignment</b> <i>Constitutional amendment that realigns public safety responsibilities from state to counties, maintains existing tax rates, and dedicatess funds to counties (for realignment) and schools.</i>	<b>ACA 2x</b>
<b>AB 18x</b>	<b>27</b>	<b>Extension of Existing Taxes ("Bridge")</b> <i>Continues existing VLF and sale tax rates (all set to expire on June 30) through June 30, 2012, and continues dependent credit level for the 2011 and 2012 tax years, and re-instates personal income tax surcharge for the 2012 tax year.</i>	<b>SB 6x</b>
<b>AB 19x</b>	<b>27</b>	<b>Nursing Home Fee</b> <i>Makes changes to extend the Quality Assurance fee on nursing homes.</i>	<b>SB 7x</b>
<b>AB 34x</b>	<b>21</b>	<b>Senior Citizens' Property Tax Assistance</b> <i>Reinstates the expired Senior Citizens' Property Tax Assistance Program.</i>	<b>SB 22x</b>
