## Strategic and Intentional Partnership

Through a strong City-County partnership, Fresno is leveraging HHAP funding to expand housing and provide essential services for people experiencing homelessness.

- Biweekly planning meetings - leadership
- Strategic jurisdictional focus and planning
- Coordinated encampment response
- Joint resource events

## System Performance Measures

- CoC tracks jurisdictional performance measures through HMIS & HDIS
- Cross-jurisdictional service provider outcomes data review
- Spending plans and spenddown presented to CoC Board of Directors
- Regular audits of subcontractors



## Accountability Data

CoC Region:

- From 1/25 to 6/25: **Over 1K** individuals exited HHAP-funded program to **permanent destination**
- Diversion - CY 2025: **Over 1,300** persons served with **91% positive exits**
- Since 2021 - City shelters: Over 11K served with **54% safe exits** and **73%** of those exits were to **permanent placements**
- Rapid Rehousing - CY 25: **Over 400 served**
