COVID-19 Data (As of January 28, 2022)

- Our website has the most current information on COVID-19 statistics, as well as recent updates to visitation, offender movement, and COVID-19 protocols.

- 6,375 Confirmed Cases of COVID-19 in CDCR Patients
 - 57,836 Cases of COVID-19 have been resolved
- 4,412 Confirmed Cases of COVID-19 in CDCR Staff
- While there's been an increase in cases due to the Omicron variant, there have been only 10 hospitalizations (no ICU admissions) since mid-December 2021.
- 81% of CDCR Patients are fully vaccinated
- 71% of CDCR Staff are fully vaccinated
- As a result of the recent Omicron-variant outbreak, all institutions are in Phase 1, as outlined in our Roadmap to Reopening.
 - *Phase I (Outbreak Phase)*—The facility has a current outbreak among the population (defined as three or more related COVID-19 cases) or is recovering from a recent outbreak (no new outbreak cases in the last 14 days).
 - *Phase II (Modified Phase)*—The facility has had no new outbreaks in the last 14 days. Must revert back to Phase I if there's a reported outbreak.
 - *Phase III (New Normal Phase)*—The facility has had no new related outbreak cases in the last 28 days. Must revert back to previous phases as appropriate if there's a reported outbreak.
